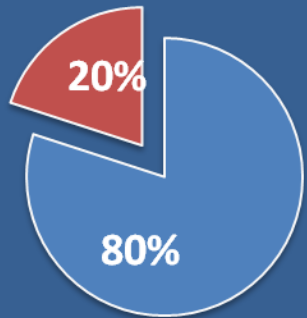

Historic Property Acquisition, Development and Planning

To improve, protect, preserve, rehabilitate or restore and acquire properties listed on the State or National Registers of Historic Places and for structural assessments or planning for such projects. Properties not currently listed but scheduled for nomination review at the State Review Board meeting of October 19, 2011, are eligible to apply for funding. This is a reimbursement program, with a 50% match requirement. Awards are capped at \$400,000. Only municipalities and not-for-profit corporations are eligible to apply.
