INTERNET/RADIO LINES

Wireless capability is available in both the press box and media work areas. All media members will receive a separate user ID and set-up code for access throughout the weekend. Should you need telephone lines or data lines, please contact Jon Lundin directly 518-302-5313 or jlundin@orda.org to make those arrangements with the venue's Operations Department.

Parking: Parking is available for a fee in a local municipal lot adjacent to the arena. The venue is within walking distance from many hotels.

Media Entrance: All media members will enter the venue to the left of the Box Office. Please follow the signs at this entrance which will lead to Media Check-in located inside the arena at the Olympic Center Reception Desk on the second level.

Credential Pick-up: Members of the media can pick-up their credentials at the Olympic Center Reception Desk, located on the second level during Thursday's open practices (times to be announced) and two hours prior to game games Friday and Saturday.

Media Meals: One media meal will be served each day of the championship on Friday as well as Saturday. Light snacks and beverages will be available in the working area throughout the championship.

Interviews: All press conferences will be held in the Ballet Room on the venue's second level, which will serve as the Media Working Area. Post-competition interviews shall be granted after a 10-minute cooling-off period. The winning coach and student-athletes shall be interviewed first with the exception of the championship game. After all official postgame press conferences, members of the media shall be allowed to interview players and student-athletes independently, but not in any locker rooms.
