Remembrance Ceremony Postponement

As you are aware, the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services (Division) administers the State of New York Police Officers Memorial (POM) and the annual Remembrance Ceremony to honor the memory and sacrifice of police officers from across New York State who have perished in the line of duty.

Due to the current impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, and after careful consideration with the Police Officers Memorial Advisory Committee (POMAC), please be advised the annual POM Remembrance Ceremony initially scheduled for Tuesday, May 4, 2021 has been postponed until Tuesday, September 28, 2021.
